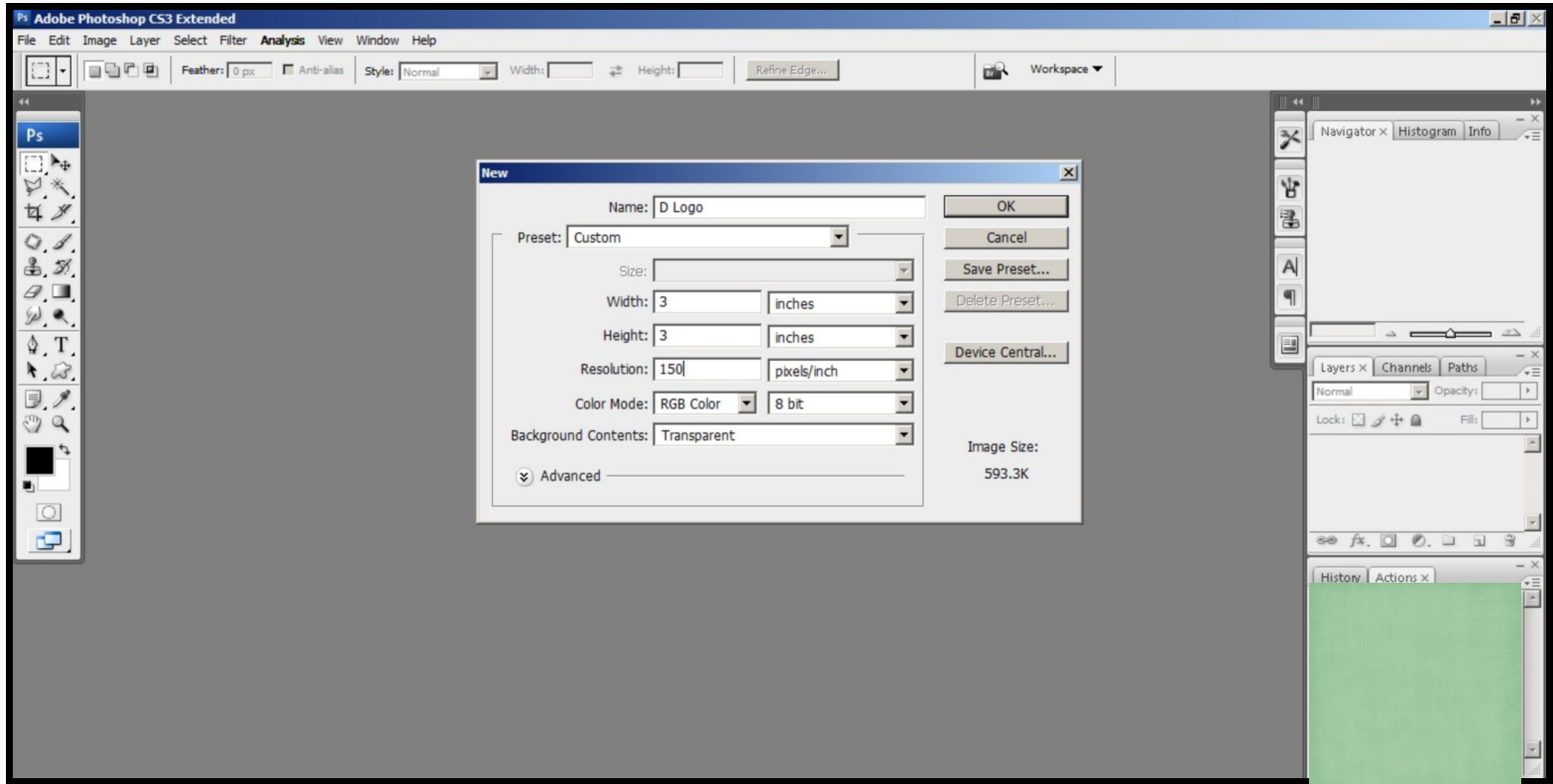
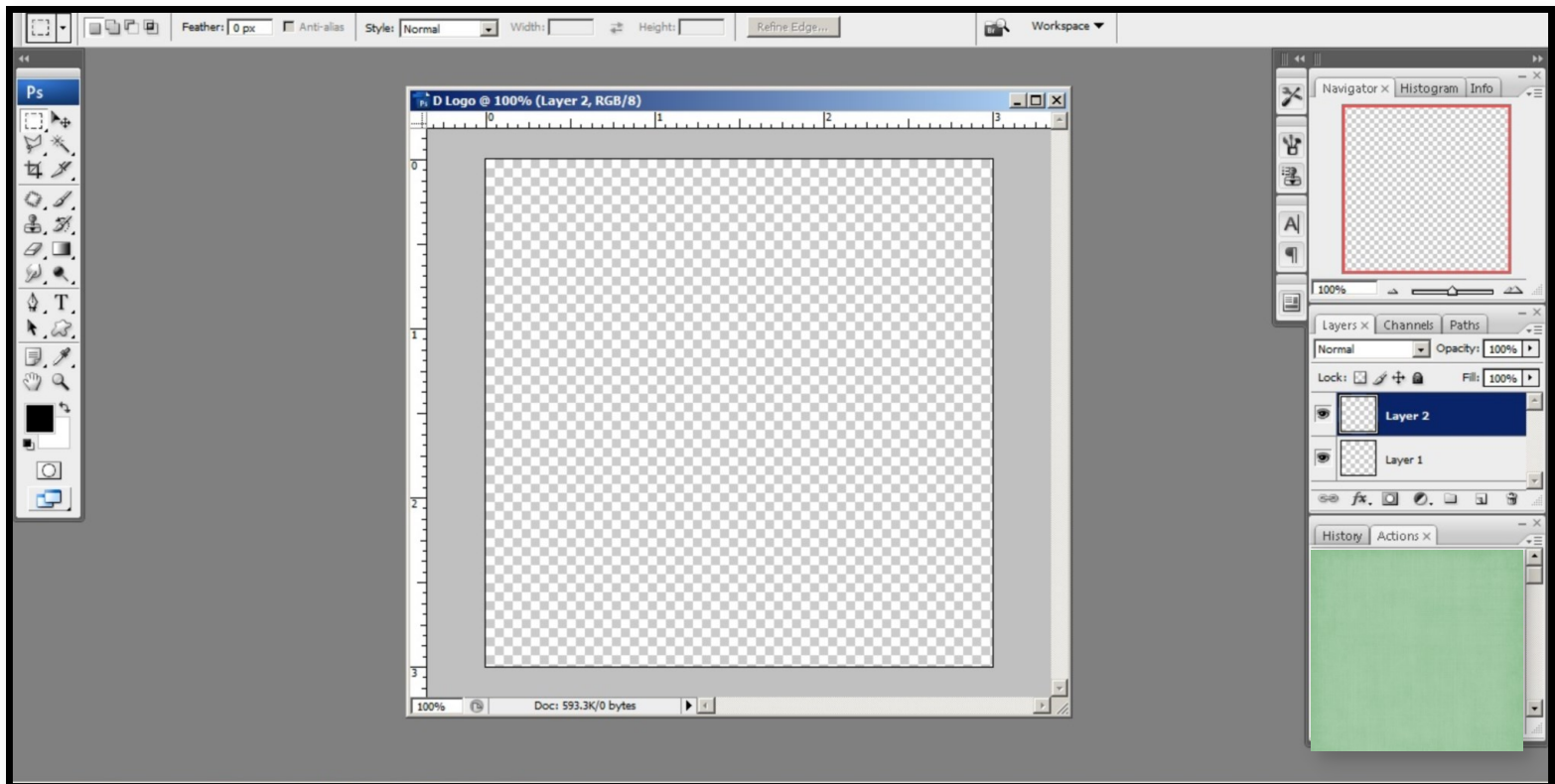


Creating a Brush Tutorial

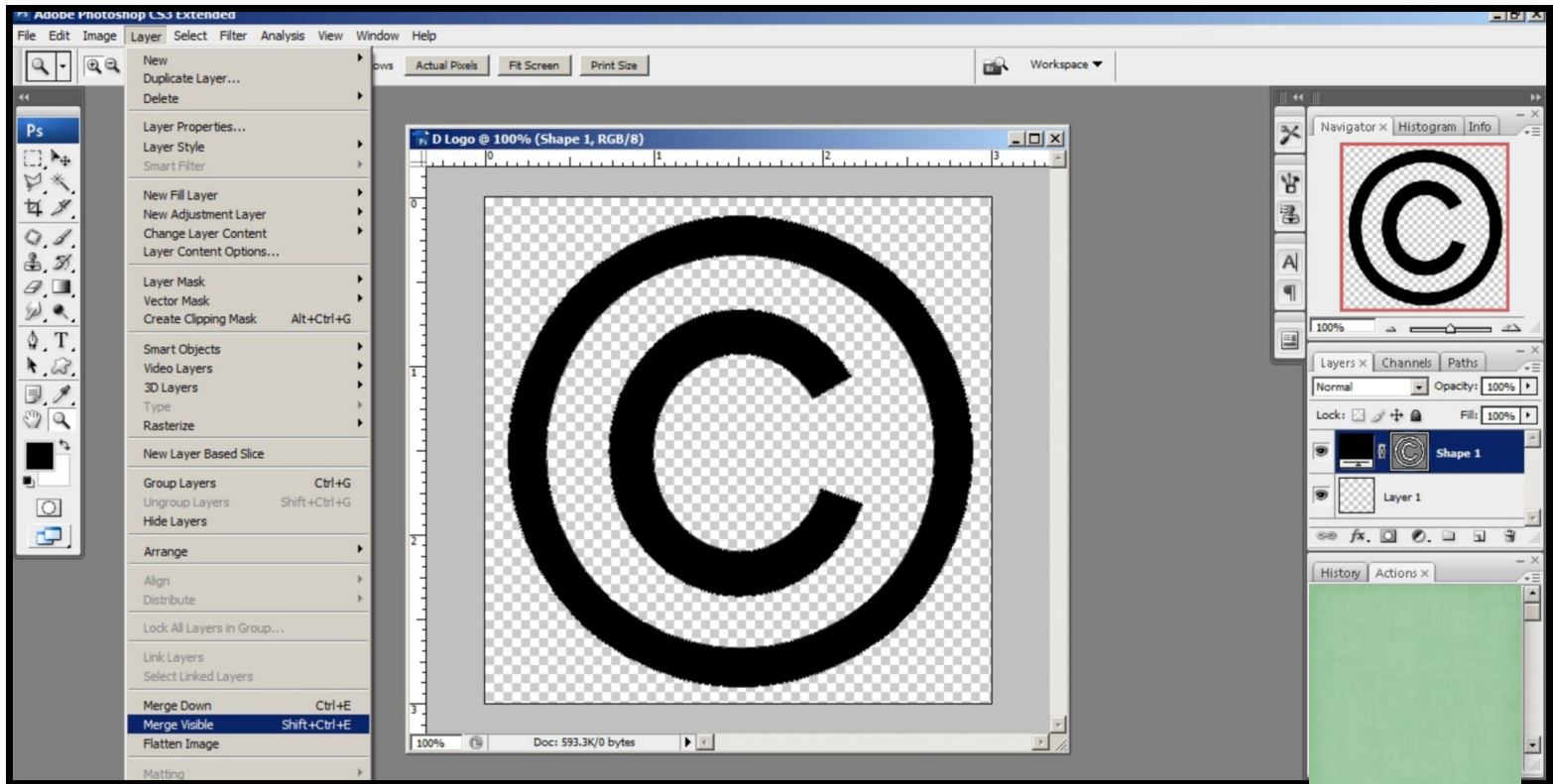


1. Open File and select New. OR CTRL+N for PC users. Name, set the size, resolution value and set the background to transparent. Click ok.

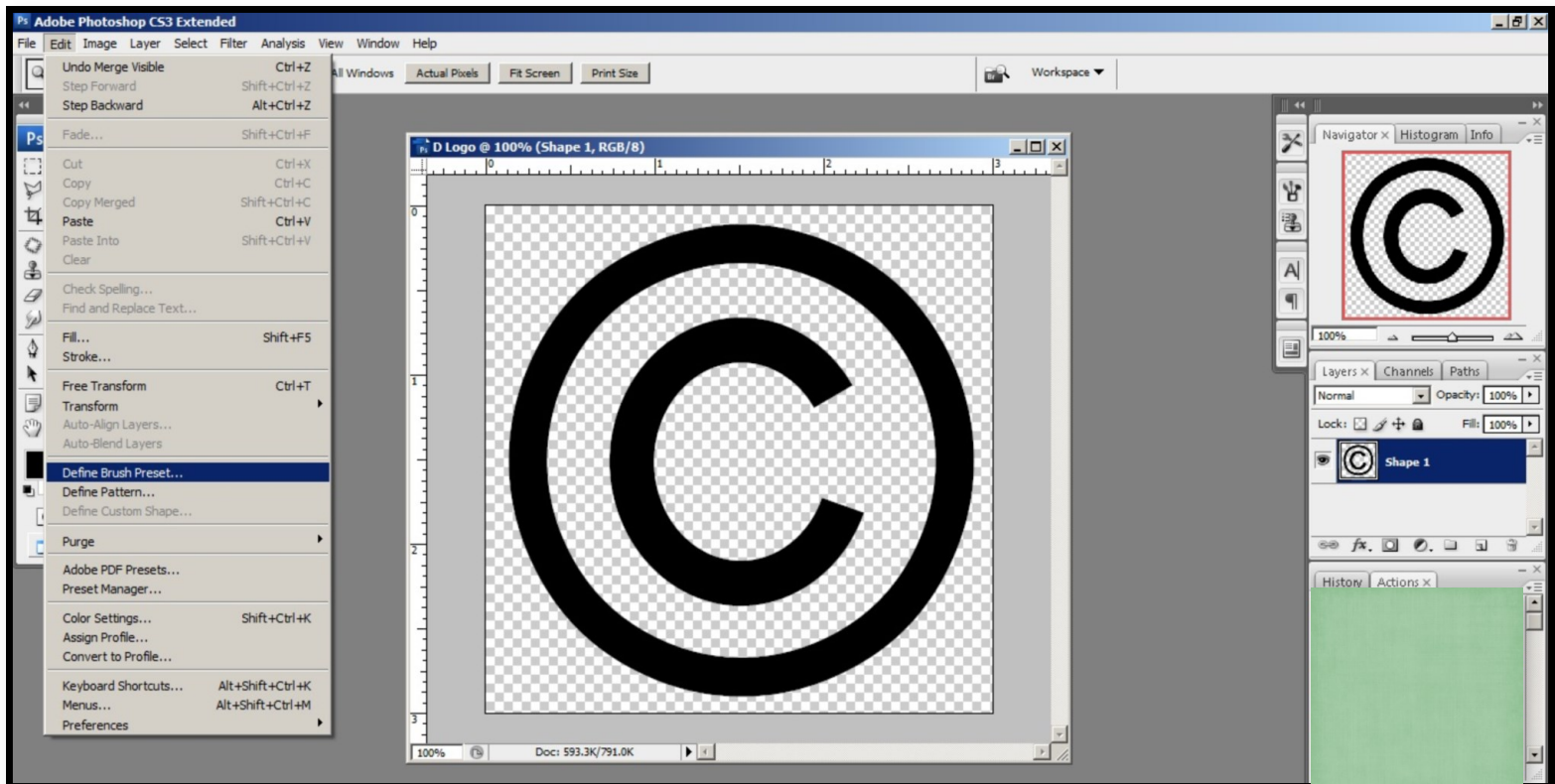


2. Create a new layer. Be sure you are using black as your design color- fonts included.

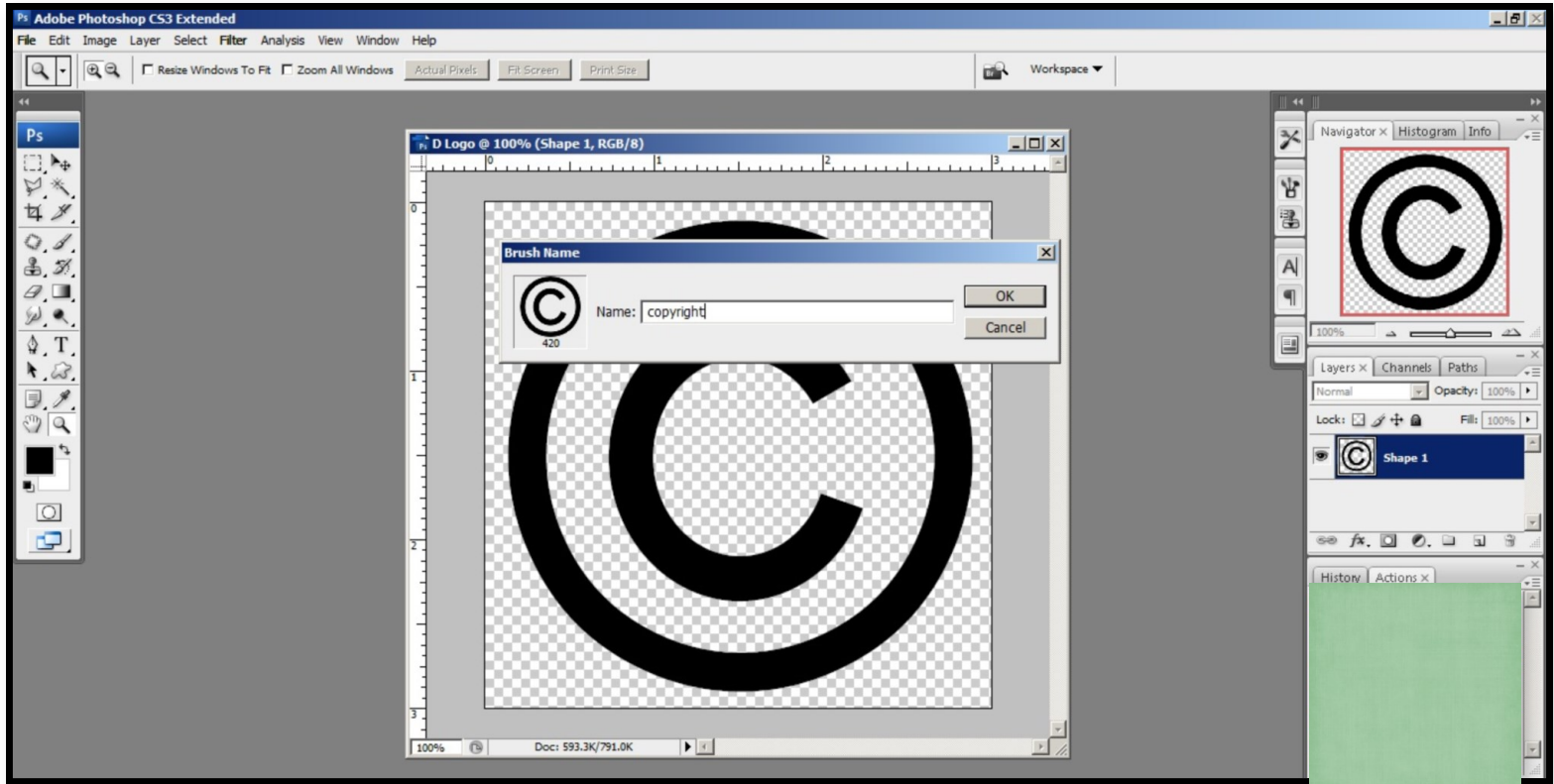


3. Merge any layers you created during the design process.

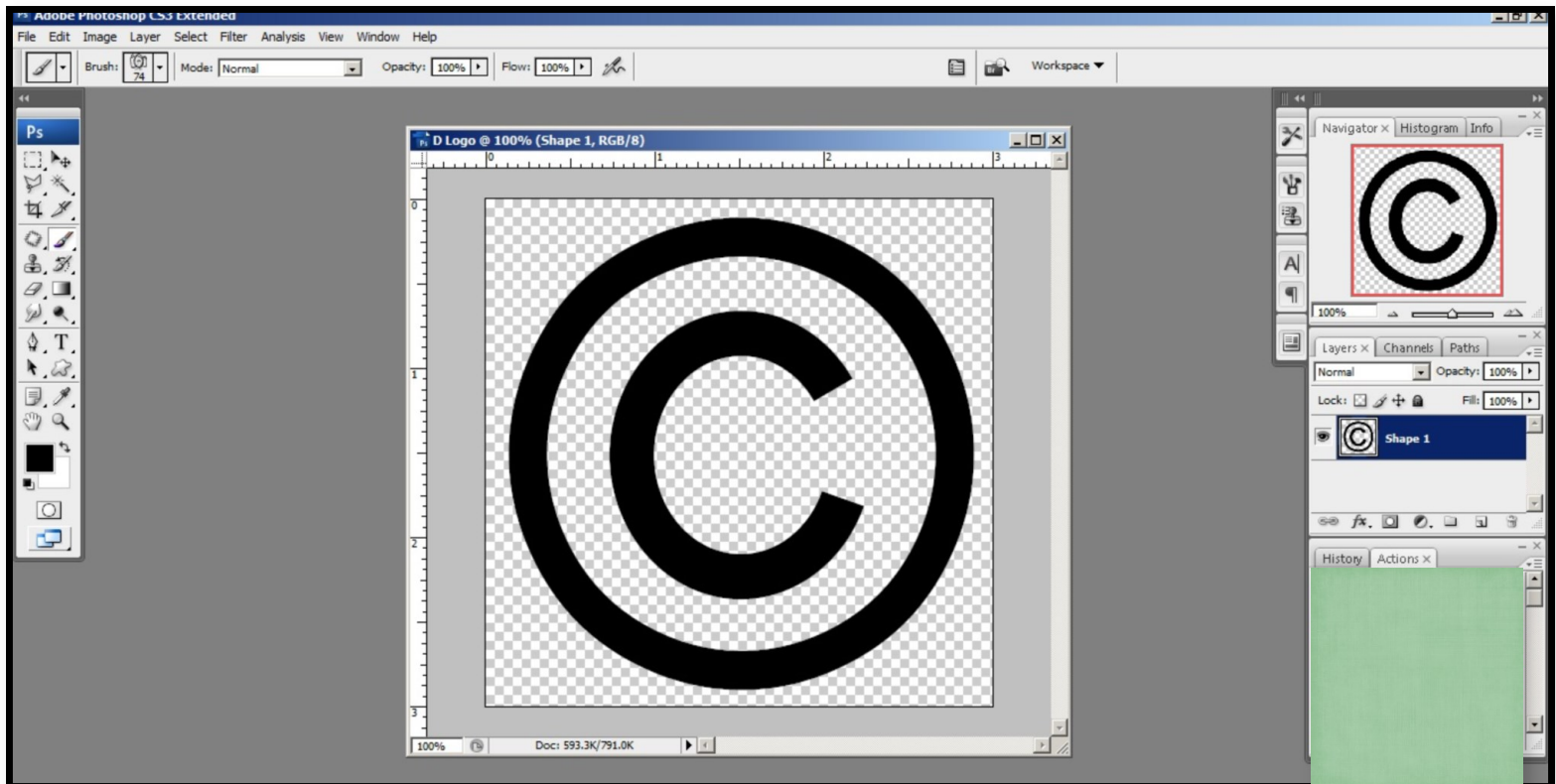


4. Choose Edit - Define Brush Preset.

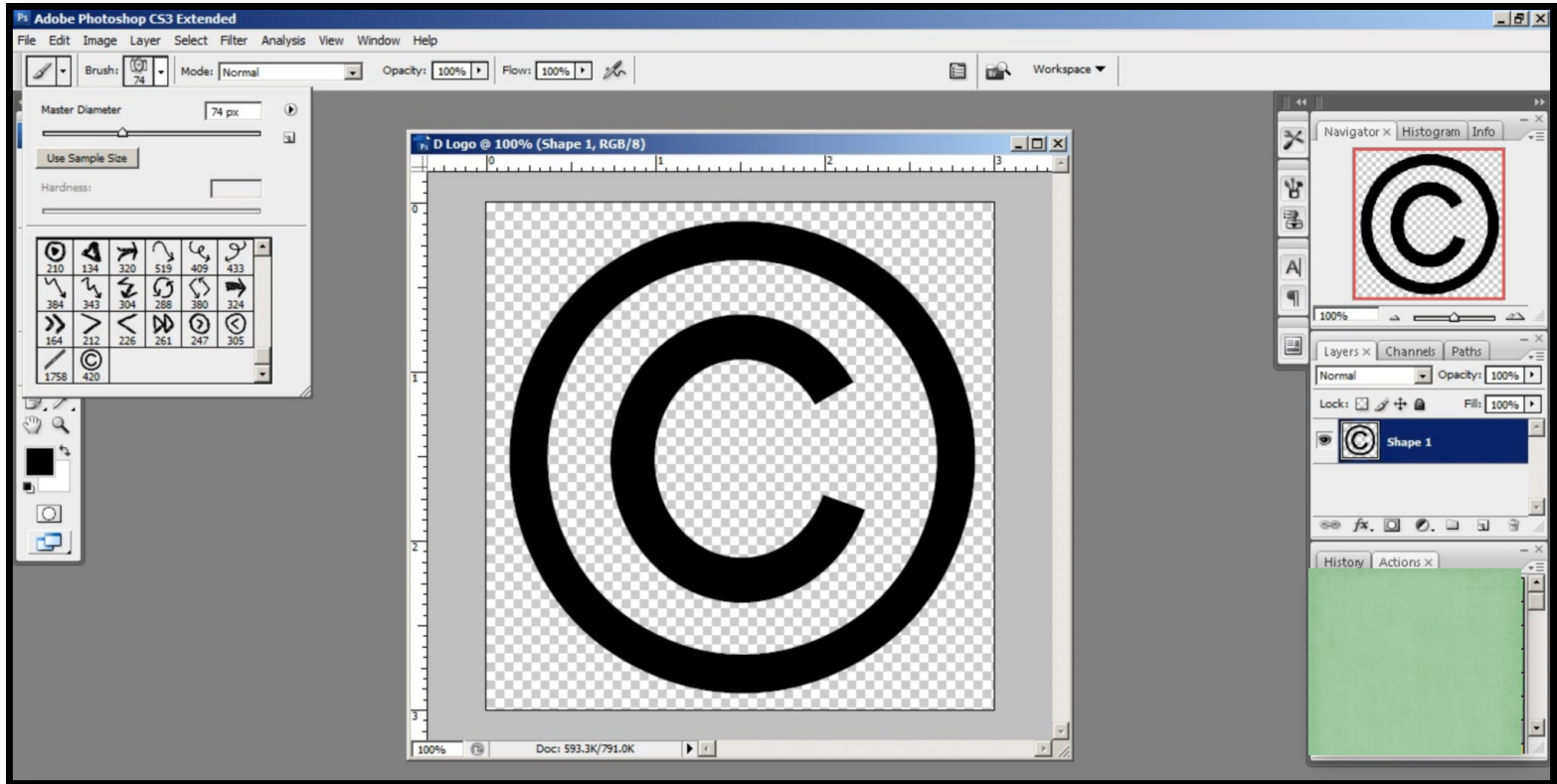


5. Name your new design/logo brush. Click OK.

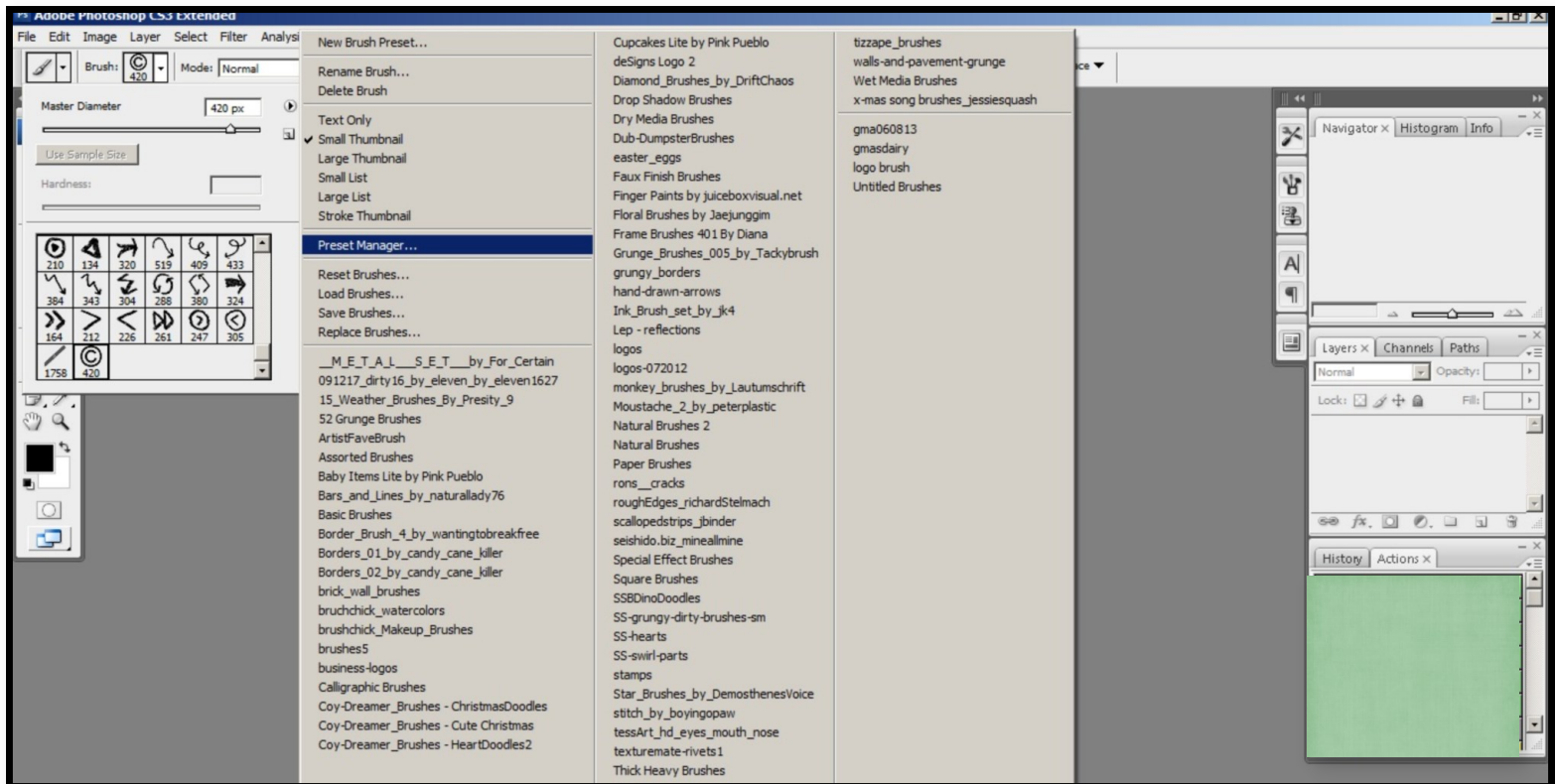


6. Click on the paintbrush tool.

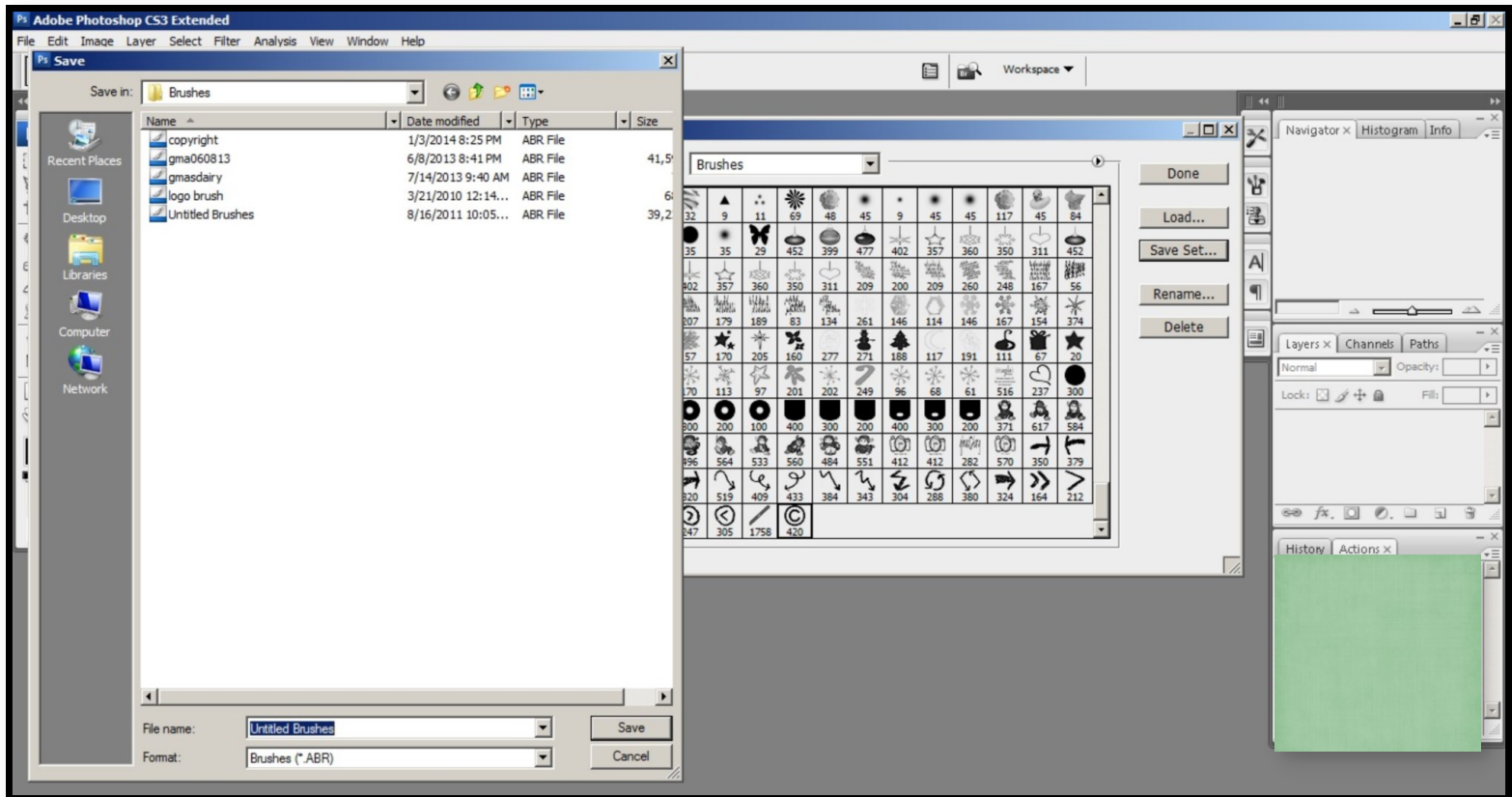


7. Look at your brush pallette at the very bottom. Your newly added brush will be in the last position.



8. Remember to save your new brush. Click on the arrow in the upper right of the brush pallette. Select the Preset Manager.

9. Select your newly created brush along with any other previous brushes to save individually or as a group. Name this set of brush(es). Finally click Save.
